

## **theSun-Mercy Malaysia Bosnia Flood Disaster Relief Fund**

Sports Toto donated RM50,000 cash to theSun-Mercy Malaysia Bosnia Flood Disaster Relief Fund in the hope to lend a helping hand to the unfortunate flood victims in Bosnia.

The contribution was handed over by Sports Toto communications manager Mr. Giam Say Khoo to The Sun Daily managing editor Freddie Ng at the headquarters of The Sun Daily on 7 August 2014.

Mr. Giam said, Sports Toto hopes its donation would help in the recovery from the floods which hit Bosnia last May, causing more than 100,000 houses to be damaged and affecting about a million people.
